Principal's Reports

Principal Paige shared there is a volunteer opportunity on Tuesday, April 20th, at the ACMA Performing Arts Center to help clean. Please contact Margaret for more details. Principal Paige also shared details regarding hybrid learning to begin at ACMA on Thursday, April 22nd. The new school rotation of A and B school days will be "ABBA". Monday – A Day, Tuesday – B Day, Wednesday Ohana- all distance learning, Thursday – B Day and Friday – A Day. Classrooms will operate a bit different based on the class. Teachers will teach to both hybrid and distance students and are striving for full inclusion of all students. Elective courses will be innovative to maintain CDC and BSD Covid public health guidelines. There will be two lunch periods. There is no School April 16-21. Friday, April 16th is Grading Day. April 19-21 are preparation days for hybrid learning. During hybrid learning locker will not be used. No visitors, including volunteers and PTO members, are permitted in the school building. School transportation information will be shared with students and families opting for hybrid learning. Graduation will take place outdoors in person on the Tumwater (Timberland) campus on June 12th. More information to be shared later through normal ACMA communication and directly to graduates and their families. The ACMA graduation ceremony will follow Beaverton School District (BSD) guidelines yet to be communicated. Graduate guests will likely be limited to two (2) per graduate. A prom may even take place this year and will also follow BSD guidelines.

Sixth and seventh grade students will have an Outdoor School experience April 26 -27, and will include hybrid and distance learning students. The events will be during the last two periods of class each day and will include outdoor activities.

ACMA will host a May the Fourth event, in celebration of Star Wars, and will take place 2:30 – 5:30 pm, schedule time for participation. The event will be like the fall 2020 walk through the outside the campus from the upper drop off area and ending in the south, lower lot for pick up.
